


CLAIM

Comes now Mark Kelly Phillips and for his claim against the Defendants jointly and severally alleges and states as follows:

1) Mark Kelly Phillips, Plaintiff, is a practicing attorney in Boonville, Warrick County, Indiana. Mark is married to Kim and the father to three (3) children, Brennan, Robert and A all of whom reside in Boonville, Warrick County, Indiana. Mark has grown up in the community of Boonville, Warrick County, Indiana, and has maintained his family, professional practice and residence in this community for forty-eight years except for the periods of time when he was at school pursuing his higher education.

Brennan is a college graduate from University of Southern Indiana, Evansville; Robert is in his fourth year as a student at University of Southern Indiana, Evansville, and A is in the 6th grade at Boonville Middle School.

Mark and his family belong to and attend church at First Christian Church in Newburgh, Indiana, which has a membership in excess of three thousand (3,000) people. Mark and his family have an active social life in the tri-state area, belong to and participate in Special Olympics Basketball where Mark has been the coach for over eighteen (18) years, winning



State Championships for seventeen (17) of those years at Butler Field House in Indianapolis, and a National Championship at the first ever National Games in 2006, membership and participation at Rolling Hills Country Club, Boonville Country Club, Quail Crossing Golf Community, Eagle Creek Golf Club, Cambridge Golf Course, Fendrich Golf Course, Helfrich Golf Course, Warrick County, Indiana and American Bar Associations, National Council Defense Bar, National College for DUI Defense, and Mark has an extensive legal practice all over the tri-state, including Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, South Carolina, and Hawaii, and in multiple counties throughout Indiana. Mark maintains an Internet website for his Law Office and belongs to the Indiana Better Business Bureau where he has an A+ rating and maintains information about his legal profession.

- That the Defendant, Nexstar Broadcasting Group, Inc., owns and operates the television station WEHT and Defendant, Mission Broadcasting, Inc., owns and operates the television station WTVW. Defendant, Nexstar Broadcasting Group, Inc., serves as the Operative Manager of Mission Broadcasting, Inc.'s television station, under a Service Agreement between the two corporations. Both television stations broadcast throughout the community of Boonville, Warrick County and the surrounding counties in the tri-state area of Indiana, Kentucky and Illinois.
- 3) That the Warrick County Prosecuting Attorney issued a Press Release, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Plaintiff's Exhibit "A", stating:

"Boonville, Indiana, November 30, 2011 - The Warrick County Prosecutor's Office announces that on November 29, 2011, Mark S. Birge entered a guilty plea in two (2) separate cases to Child Molesting. The Defendant is represented by Mark Phillips.

The State filed charges against Mark Birge on June 29, 2010 and September 29, 2010 after investigations were conducted by the Boonville Police Department. Two children had disclosed the molesting during interviews conducted at Holly's House.

Trial Deputy Jennifer Greer is assigned the case. Prosecutor JoAnn Krantz commended Deputy Greer for her work on the cases.

The range of sentencing for the C Felonies is 4-16 years at the Indiana Department of Correction. The Defendant is set for Sentencing on January 12, 2012 at 8:30 a.m. before the Honorable Judge Robert R. Aylsworth."

4) That both Defendants on or about November 30, 2011 and December 1, 2011 published verbally by broadcast on the news, and by written release posted on their website, on multiple occasions, the following statement about Mark Kelly Phillips, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated hereby as Plaintiff's Exhibit "B":

"BOONVILLE, IN - A Boonville man is awaiting sentencing for two counts of child molesting.

According to the Warrick County Prosecutor's Office, Mark Phillips pleaded guilty to the two charges Tuesday.

Two children told Holly's House representatives about the molestations in 2010.

Phillips faces 4 to 16 years in prison. He will be sentenced January 12th."

COUNT 1 SLANDER PER SE

- 5) That the Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, restates and incorporates herein, by reference, the factual allegations setforth in rhetorical paragraphs 1 through 4.
- 6) That the Defendants published on their news broadcasts, on multiple occasions, the statement that Mark Phillips is awaiting sentencing for two counts of child molesting, that Mark Phillips pleaded guilty to the two charges Tuesday, and that two children told Holly's

House representatives about the molestations in 2010, and that Phillips faces 4 to 16 years in prison. He will be sentenced January 12th. Said published statements by the Defendants that Mark Phillips was a convicted child molester were published with knowledge of its falsity and the Defendants acted with reckless disregard for the truth.

- 7) That the Defendants committed slander per se by falsely claiming that Mark Phillips committed a crime of moral turpitude.
- 8) That Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, has suffered humiliation, indignation, emotional distress, and grievous and substantial damages to his reputation and character as a result of the false reporting by the Defendants of being a convicted child molester, has suffered ridicule, damage to his professional and personal reputation within the community and the tristate area, emotional and physical pain, disgrace, and stress within his marriage and with his family, embarrassment and loss of opportunity to achieve his potential as a professional and will continue to sustain substantial damages into the future.

COUNT II LIBEL PER SE

- 9) That Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, restates and incorporates herein, by reference, the factual allegations setforth in rhetorical paragraphs 1 through 8.
- That the Defendants published the written false statement that Mark Phillips is awaiting sentencing for two counts of child molesting, that according to the Warrick County Prosecutor's Office, that Mark Phillips pleaded guilty to two charges Tuesday, that two children told Holly's House representations about the molestations in 2010, and that Phillips faces 4-16 years in prison and will be sentenced on January 12th. On the website of the two television stations, the Defendants transmitted the false statement over the Internet.

- That by their actions, Defendants committed libel per se by falsely printing and publishing the statement that Mark Phillips committed a crime of moral turpitude, child molesting.
- 12) That Mark Kelly Phillips has suffered substantial damages as setforth in paragraph 8 and incorporated herein by reference.

COUNT III DEFAMATION

- 13) That Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, restates and incorporates herein, by reference, the factual allegations setforth in rhetorical paragraphs 1 through 12.
- 14) That the Defendants have published spoken and written false statements that

 Mark Phillips of Boonville is awaiting sentencing on two counts of child molesting, that Mark

 Phillips pleaded guilty to the two charges Tuesday, that two children told Holly's House

 representatives about the molestations in 2010, and that Phillips faces 4-16 years in prison and
 will be sentenced on January 12th, all as set forth in Exhibit "B".
- 15) That said statements were made by the Defendants with knowledge of their falsity and acted with reckless disregard for the truth and with malice; that said false statements have imputed defamation to the reputation and character of Mark Kelly Phillips within the community and the surrounding tri-state and has resulted in damages to the Plaintiff as enumerated in rhetorical paragraph 8 of this Claim.

<u>COUNT IV</u> <u>PUNITIVE DAMAGES</u>

16) That Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, restates and incorporates herein, by reference, the factual allegations setforth in rhetorical paragraphs 1 through 15.

17) That the publications by Defendants of the false statements of moral turpitude, child molesting by Mark Phillips, as setforth in Exhibit "B", demonstrated that Defendants engaged in purposeful misconduct, constituting malice, fraud and gross negligence which is so reprehensible as to warrant the award of punitive damages.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Mark Kelly Phillips, prays that the Court enter judgment, jointly and severally, against both Defendants and in favor of the Plaintiff, for compensatory and punitive damages, for the costs of this action and for all atter just and proper relief in the premises.
